JOB SUMMARY

The Horticultural Assistant will undertake a range of tasks involving the cultivation, growing, and maintenance of ornamental plantings throughout the Resort and its properties.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Prepare new garden sites, plots and soils using hand tools or machines.
- Load, unload and move gardening supplies and equipment.
- Assist with planting and transplanting seeds, bulbs, flowers and shrubs.
- Tending plants by hand watering and weeding.
- Trim and prune hedges and shrubbery.
- Maintain plants and gardens by watering, weeding and fertilizing.
- Weeding, and trimming grasses.
- Tending plants by hand watering and weeding.

- Knowledge of the characteristics, growth habits and proper cultivation of a wide selection of flowering bulbs, annuals, biennials and perennial plant materials, including both herbaceous and woody plants.
